A STORY is told of a man in Russia who became a Christian. He had been a member of the brutal police force in his city under the communist regime for many years. 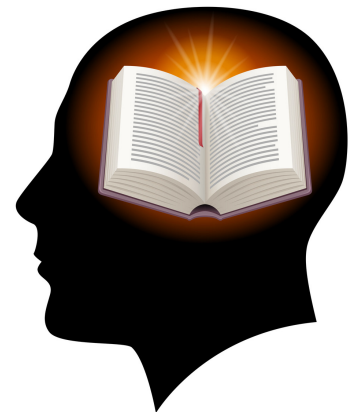
Actually, the "pest" was also a new brother in Christ. Some people have lived in sin for so long that their hearts have become hardened, and it is difficult for them to change their way of living even after

It's a process of transformation that requires us to renew our minds and hearts continually.

living with the Spirit of Christ in us. If we are tempted to use language that we formerly used or act as we did before becoming Christians, let's remember that we are new creations in Christ. We can pray for His strength, knowing that He will bless us and help us live in the newness of His grace.

What are Headaches? A headache is a pain in your head or face, often described as a pressure that's throbbing, constant, sharp, or dull. Headaches can differ greatly in terms of pain type, severity, location, and frequency. They occur in adults and children.

What is the main cause of Headaches? Headache pain results from signals interacting among your brain, blood vessels, and surrounding nerves. During a headache, multiple mechanisms activate specific nerves that affect muscles and blood vessels. These nerves send pain signals to your brain, causing a headache. They are the most common form of pain and are a major reason cited for days missed at work or school, as well as visits to healthcare providers. While most headaches aren't dangerous, certain types can be a sign of a more serious condition.

Most Common Types of Headaches

Primary Headaches—They are not a symptom of or caused by an underlying medical condition. □

Tension—The most common type of headache; usually mild to moderate and feels like constant pressure on the face, head, or neck. Muscle pain is like a belt being tightened around the head. *Most people feel pain on both sides of the head.*

Migraines—A migraine attack is a moderate to severe throbbing pain that usually happens on one side of the head. Often associated with light and noise sensitivity, nausea, and fatigue. Occasionally, one-sided weakness or numbness

Secondary Headaches—They are a symptom of another health condition

When to Contact Your Healthcare Provider

- ✓ A sudden, severe headache, possibly with a stiff neck
- ✓ A severe headache with fever, nausea, or vomiting that's not related to another illness
- ✓ A person experiencing their "first" or "worst" headache that also has confusion, weakness, double vision, or loss of consciousness
- ✓ A headache that gets worse over days or weeks or changes in pattern or behavior
- ✓ Headaches in children that keep coming back
- ✓ A headache after a brain injury
- ✓ A headache with loss of sensation or weakness in any part of the body—this could be a sign of a stroke
- ✓ A headache with convulsions (shaking) or trouble breathing
- ✓ Two or more headaches a week
- ✓ A constant headache in someone who hasn't had headaches before, especially if they're over age 5

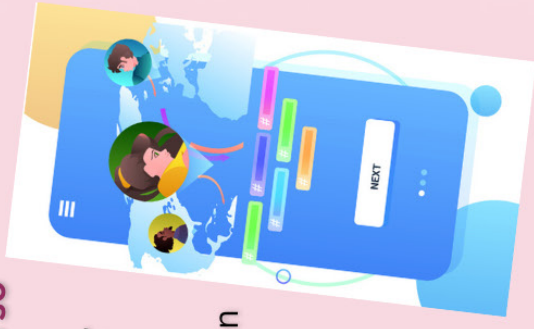
