THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD

"Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; *I am* God, and there is no one like Me," Isaiah 46:9 (NASB)

ou can do anything you want if you just put your mind to it." I've heard that said often, but is it true? Are the successes and failures of our lives simply a matter of self-determination?

This sounds logical, but unfortunately, we cannot rely on our logic. Consider the words of Solomon, arguably one of the wisest men ever to live: "There is a way *which seems* right to a person, But its end is the way of death." (Proverbs 16:25). The way of self-determination feels right to us, but Solomon tells us otherwise.

Solomon expands on this truth in Proverbs 16:9: "The mind of a person plans his way, But the LORD directs his steps." We can plan to go a certain way and do certain things, but God ultimately determines our steps.

I admit that this is not an easy truth to accept. My own heart struggles with the breadth of God's sovereignty. But there is unspeakable joy in accepting that I am the clay and He is the Potter. This truth sets us free from the burden of self-determination.



Hello GACC Personal Evangelist,

We have a special ask of all teachers who have taught the Good News to someone who then obeyed the Gospel. We must ensure that all new converts are fully and appropriately taught about the church of Christ at Greenville Avenue. We would appreciate your help, GACC, in ensuring that the new convert has attended Orientation and been introduced to the New Convert Class on Sunday morning and Wednesday night.

Teaching someone the Plan of Salvation is not enough to cultivate their spiritual growth. We need to confirm that the new convert has the opportunity to establish relationships with other members of the body. This step will help GACC's Leadership embrace these brothers and sisters and assist them in building a stable foundation as they continue to grow and develop in their Christian walk.


Once they have been baptized, I recommend you guide and direct them onto the pathway of righteousness. Leading a person to water is insufficient, and there is no contingency plan to ensure the new convert has been given a solid foundational study. Once your **student** has completed the Open Bible Study (OBS) and obeyed the Gospel, you should begin teaching the **new convert**.

Again, if you have instructed someone using only the Plan of Salvation, that's not enough. As the tutor who taught the person, your added responsibility is to assist them in becoming disciples, who will then go and make more disciples.

Our supplemental study, The New Christian, will ensure that the new convert has a lifeline, someone who will continue to be by their side, thus eliminating the possibility of **FALLING AWAY.** If you want a copy, I will provide one for you and the new convert; please let me know.

Finally, not only do we want to save lost souls, but we also want to provide a foundation that will keep them saved. Let's utilize the four Gs: **G**aining, **G**rounding, **G**rowing, and **G**lorifying God.




Blood Transfusion Is Needed

- Every 10 seconds, someone in the U.S. needs blood, according to the American Red Cross.
